Feature	Why It Matters	What to Ask/Do
Dwelling Coverage	If your home cost to rebuild is higher than your coverage, you would pay the difference.	Ask: "If I needed to rebuild today, is my coverage enough? Often times, agents have software to help determine
Deductible	That's how much you pay first before insurance pays. A higher deductible lowers your premium — but means more out-of-pocket risk.	See if you can afford a slightly higher deductible.
Discounts	Some things can lower your cost	Ask your insurer if you're getting all discounts: bundling multiple policies, install safety features of upgraded construction materials.
